There has been a need for a long time for an alerting system to tell children when it is time to go .. before there is wetting. Dr Helal Malem has now designed the . ***Vibro- watch*** for this function. The

Malem Vibro-watch is easy to use and is attractive for a child to wear as a watch to tell the time but also provides vibrations at the wrist to alert child, parent or other person ... to go to the toilet, to take medications, to take some exercise, etc.

The watch can be set to vibrate at specific intervals that match the needs of the person eg it can be set to change the interval between going to the toilet - to anticipate a full bladder and avoid wetting, or to extend the time until a toilet visit to increase bladder capacity. The interval between alarm vibrations can be varied up to an alarm each 24 hours, to one every minute (although it is not quite clear when that will be needed) or anything in between eg 2-4 hourly for bladder training or at specific times.
